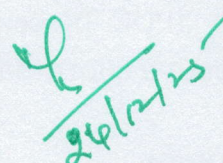

NAAC Update:

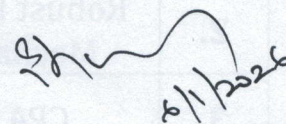
- The NAAC Champions are in the process of completing the pending items, and all deliverables are scheduled to be finalized by the first week of January 2026.
